CHILD SAFETY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION

Our commitment

- Zero tolerance for child abuse, racism, homophobia, transphobia, bullying or discrimination.
- All children and young people have the right to feel safe and be safe in our spaces, regardless of gender, sexuality, culture, religion, disability, family situation or background.
- We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, culturally and linguistically diverse communities, children with disability, LGBTIQA+ children and young people, and those who may be more vulnerable.
- We respect each person's name, pronouns and identity.
- Bullying, harassment or discrimination is treated as a child safety concern.

Our child safety commitments

- All staff, teaching artists, volunteers and Board members follow EGAG's Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy, Procedures and Code of Conduct.
- Everyone working with children holds a current Working with Children Check and receives child safety training.
- Children and young people are supervised at all times, and we work to keep our physical and online spaces safe.
- We listen to children and young people and provide clear ways to speak up if something doesn't feel right.
